Thompson Crossing is located in the South-eastern corner of Marion County in the Franklin Township Community School Corporation. Thompson Crossing serves approximately 600 students in grades K-5. The school population consists of 70% Caucasian, 8% Hispanic, 6% Black, 5% Multiracial, and 11% Asian. Thompson Crossing is a Title 1 school and has approximately 34% of students qualify for free and reduced lunch assistance. Thompson Crossing serves around 60 students in need of support as English Language Learners. The school also offers a magnet program for high ability students with a self-contained classroom in grades 3, 4, and 5. Inclusion and self-contained special education classrooms are also available, including a Comprehensive Intervention Program (CIP) classroom. We strive to meet the needs of all learners through our variety of classrooms and differentiated practice within every classroom.
